






# Hub Happenings

Across the Hub network, partners hosted impactful events, launched






## Rural Community College Alliance (RCCA) Apprenticeship Webinar

US Departments of Labor, Education implement workforce development partnership | U.S. Department of Labor

The U.S. Departments of Labor and Education announced the implementation of a workforce development partnership to create an integrated federal education and workforce system. The Labor Department will take on a greater role in administering the adult education and family literacy programs.

US Department of Labor launches online resource to increase employment opportunities for 5 million disabled veterans | U.S. Department of Labor

The U.S. Department of Labor announced the launch of the Veterans Accommodations Toolkit, a resource aimed at increasing employment rates and participation in apprenticeship programs for disabled American veterans.
